Our hearts are heavy as we mourn the brutal murder of George Floyd (z"l) in Minneapolis at the hands of police.

As the talmud teaches us, "Whoever destroys a single life, it is as if they destroyed an entire world." The violence of white supremacy is never singular — the systemic racism that allows Black people to be murdered with impunity is destroying our whole world.

We know that the uprisings taking place all around the country right now, from Minneapolis to Raleigh to Asheville, may have been sparked by George Floyd's death, but that they are also happening in response to centuries of violence and oppression, countless lost lives, and the destruction of entire worlds — worlds which can never be reclaimed.

We can, however, build new worlds, and Carolina Jews for Justice stands in solidarity with the Black leaders — within our Jewish community and beyond — who are actively fighting for and constructing that future.
