Shavuah tov to all. It is with profound heaviness that we begin this week in mourning; honoring the lives of George Floyd, Ahmaud Arbery, Breonna Taylor, Tony McDade, Sean Reed, and countless other precious lives taken by state violence, white supremacy, and the anti-Blackness that is at the core of policing and the society in which we live.

As we witness the swell of uprising and public action around the country, we are honoring the pain, courage, and power that is at the heart of these movements and communities, as their power and grief echos across dozens of US cities and beyond.



In this moment, Kavod is recommitting ourselves as individuals, as a collective, and as a multiracial Jewish community, to dismantling policing, uprooting anti-Blackness, and supporting the creation of local, community-based solutions.

As always, we urge our community to follow the lead of national and local Black-led organizations; such as the Movement for Black Lives, BYP100, Color of Change, and those working on the ground in Minneapolis, Louisville, and Georgia.
